Born in Mayari, Oriente (Cuba), he studied painting, sculpture & engraving in 1963 at the School for Art in Structures in Miramar, Havana (Cuba). In 1967 he worked as a graphic designer in his hometown. In 1968 he studied cinematographic animated drawings on National TV, in Havana (Cuba).

In 1969 was called to be inducted into the military service & it was not until 1972, when work, in the Public Health Ministry, was begun, in the province of Holguin, Oriente (Cuba), as an interior decorator specialist on said health institution. He worked in public health until 1990.



Simultaneously, decorations were made in more than 20 public schools, elementary & secondary, as well as in children circles, creating on each one painted murals.

From 1986 until 1990 he also did cartooning for the newspaper "AHORA", the most important one in his hometown.

In 1976 he received 1st prize from TV Channel 5, in Santiago de Cuba, Oriente.

In 1977 he received 2nd prize from the Soviet weekly publication "Hovedades de Noscú"

From 1980 thru 1990 he participated in artistic exhibitions in his province & township. He simultaneously created multiple graphic designs for different ministries of the province.
