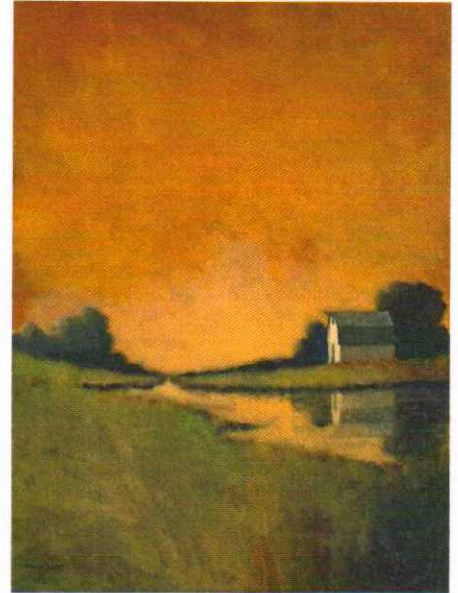


Thomas Stotts
